Sharon Moffatt is the Chief of Health Promotion and Disease Prevention for The Association of State and Territorial Health Officials. She represents ASTHO on the National Forum Coordinating Board. ASTHO is the national nonprofit organization representing the state and territorial public health agencies of the United States, the U.S. Territories, and the District of Columbia. ASTHO's members, the chief health officials of these jurisdictions, are dedicated to formulating and influencing sound public health policy, and to assuring excellence in state-based public health practice.

Prior to joining ASTHO, Moffatt served as Interim Commissioner of the Vermont Department of Health and Deputy Commissioner of Health for the state of Vermont. She also served as the State Director of Public Health Nursing and Assistant Director of the Division of Community Public Health for seven years. She worked as a public health nurse for over 25 years in clinics, homes, schools and numerous other community settings. Moffatt was also an Adjunct Assistant Professor at the University of Vermont, School of Nursing.

Moffatt has also worked in the areas of environmental health, refugee health, maternal child health, school health, and children's mental health. Throughout her public health career, she has worked with a wide variety of public health and health care professionals and key community partners to systematically improve the health of all Vermonters. Moffatt is an active member of the American Public Health Association and the Association of State and Territorial Health Officials, and is a past president of the Association of State and Territorial Directors of Nursing.
